

3745-31-10 AIR STATIONARY SOURCE OBLIGATIONS.

**(A)** COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER REQUIREMENTS

THE APPROVAL TO CONSTRUCT UNDER THIS CHAPTER SHALL NOT RELIEVE ANY OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A STATIONARY SOURCE OF THE RESPONSIBILITY TO COMPLY FULLY WITH APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THESE RULES AND ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS UNDER LOCAL, STATE OR FEDERAL LAW.

(B) RELAXATION OF ENFORCEABLE LIMITATIONS

AT SUCH TIME THAT A PARTICULAR STATIONARY SOURCE OR MODIFICATION BECOMES A MAJOR STATIONARY SOURCE OR MAJOR MODIFICATION SOLELY BY VIRTUE OF A RELAXATION IN ANY ENFORCEABLE LIMITATION ESTABLISHED AFTER AUGUST 7, 1980, ON THE CAPACITY OF THE STATIONARY SOURCE OR MODIFICATION OTHERWISE TO EMIT AN AIR POLLUTANT, SUCH AS A RESTRICTION ON HOURS OF OPERATION, THE REQUIREMENTS OF RULE 3745-31-10 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE THROUGH RULE 3745-31-27 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE SHALL APPLY TO THE STATIONARY SOURCE OR MODIFICATION AS THOUGH CONSTRUCTION HAD NOT YET COMMENCED ON THE STATIONARY SOURCE OR MODIFICATION.
