Pursuant to Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, (87 Stat. 884, as amended; 16 U.S. C. 1531 et seq.), the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed the biological information and analysis related to a Prevention of Significant Deterioration permit for the Marathon Petroleum Company LLC, Detroit, Michigan, refinery for their Detroit Heavy Oil Upgrade Project to determine what impact there may be to any threatened or endangered species in the area around the proposed facility. The purpose of this letter is to seek concurrence from the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service on our determination that the proposed project is not likely to adversely affect any federally listed species in relation to the proposed air quality permit for this facility.
