NOTICE OF VIOLATION

The Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) is issuing this Notice of Violation under Section 113(a)(1) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(a)(1). U.S. EPA finds that Cade Autoair, Inc., violated the Michigan State Implementation Plan (SIP), as follows:

Statutory and Regulatory Background

1. Michigan Air Pollution Control Commission R336.1702 (Rule 702) was approved by the Administrator of the U.S. EPA on November 7, 1994 (59 Fed. Reg. 46182), as part of the federally enforceable SIP for Michigan.
2. Rule 702 sets forth emission limitations and prohibitions of air contaminants under the Air Pollution Act of Michigan. Rule 702(c) states, in part, "... a person who is responsible for any new source of volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions shall not cause or allow the emission of VOC emissions from the new source in excess of...The maximum allowable emission rate specified as a condition of a permit to install..."

Cade Autoair, Inc.'s Degreaser Operation

3. Cade Autoair, Inc., owns and operates a Detrex trichloroethylene batch vapor degreaser (degreaser) at its Lansing, Michigan facility.
4. Cade Autoair, Inc., was issued a permit to install on September 10, 1986, Michigan Permit to Install No. 356-86.


5. The permit to install condition No. 10 limited Cade Autoair, Inc. to 1.51 tons of trichloroethylene emitted per year.

Violations

6. In 1997 Cade Autoair, Inc., emitted 2.6 tons of trichloroethylene into the air and therefore was in violation of its permit to install, and the federally enforceable SIP.


