

Dear Ms. Mrosinski:

Pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), 16 U.S.C. § 470, et seq., I am writing to notify you that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed a construction permit for Prestige Custom Cabinetry in Green Bay, Wisconsin, to determine what impact there may be on listed or eligible historic properties. Specifically, EPA notified Prestige Custom Cabinetry that it is required to implement steps to assure compliance with the NHPA and its implementing regulations. The purpose of this letter is to seek concurrence from you on our determination that the proposed project will have no adverse effect in relation to the Tribal minor New Source Review (NSR) permit for this facility.

Prestige Custom Cabinetry has submitted an application to obtain from EPA a minor NSR construction permit for its existing plant located in Green Bay, (Brown County). I have enclosed a copy of Prestige Custom Cabinetry's November 19, 2013, permit application for your review. Prestige Custom Cabinetry is an existing source that is applying for an "after the fact" construction permit from EPA. Previously, the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources issued a synthetic minor non-Part 70 air pollution source operation permit to Prestige Custom Cabinetry in December 2009. However, the State of Wisconsin does not have jurisdiction to issue permits to sources within the exterior boundaries of Tribal reservations such as the Oneida Nation. Based upon the information submitted and EPA's understanding of the proposed permitting action not modifying the existing facility, EPA finds that the proposed permitting action will have no adverse effect on any listed or eligible historic properties.

By this letter, EPA is fulfilling its obligations pursuant to Section 106 of the NHPA for the Prestige Custom Cabinetry permitting action. If you have questions with respect to this letter or disagree with this determination, please contact Constantine Blathras, of my staff, at (312) 886-0671.
