FINDING OF VIOLATION

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), hereby notifies the State of Michigan and Tri-K Cylinder Service Inc. (Tri-K), located at 4539 Wayne Road, Springfield, Michigan, that Tri-K is in violation of the Clean Air Act (Act), 42 U.S.C. § 7401 et seq. Tri-K is in violation of Section 112 of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7412, and regulations setting forth National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPS) for hard and Decorative Chromium Electroplating and Chromium Anodizing Tanks, 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.340-347 (Chrome NESHAP) as follows:

- (1) Tri-K did not submit an initial notification for the two electroplating tanks by July 25, 1995. This is a violation of 40 C.F.R. § 63.347(c)(1).
- (2) Tri-K did not test the two electroplating tanks by July 25, 1997. This is a violation of 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.7 and 63.344.
- (3) Tri-K did not prepare an operating and maintenance plan for the two electroplating tanks by July 25, 1997. This is a violation of 40 C.F.R. § 63.342(f)(3)(i).
