Enclosed is a copy of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Order responding to the petition submitted by the Sierra Club, the Clean Water Action Council and the Midwest Environmental Defense Center. The petition requested that the Administrator object to the Clean Air Act (Act) Title V renewal permit issued by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to Georgia-Pacific Consumer Products. The Order, which the Administrator issued on July 23, 2012, denies the petition.

In addition, section 505(b)(2) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7661d(b)(2), provides that any denial of a petition is subject to judicial review under section 307 of the Act. Pursuant to section 307(b)(1) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1), the petitioners may, within 60 days of publication of notice of this decision in the Federal Register, seek judicial review of EPA's denials in the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit.
