Pursuant to Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, (87 Stat. 884, as amended; 16 U.S. C. 1531 et seq.), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed the biological information and analysis related to a Prevention of Significant Deterioration permit for a proposed modification at Winpak Heat Seal Corporation at its facility in Pekin, Illinois, to determine what impact there may be to any threatened or endangered species in the area around the facility. Winpak Heat and Seal Corporation specializes in the flexographic printing, coating, and finishing of aluminum foil and plastic for various food, beverage, dairy, and healthcare markets. Amec Foster Wheeler Environment & Infrastructure, Inc. has prepared an analysis for the project on behalf of Winpak Heat and Seal Corporation, dated February 2016 (See enclosure). EPA has reviewed the analysis and has determined that the project may affect, but is not likely to adversely affect, any federally listed species.
