In September 2004, my staff transmitted a new Title V operating permit program data tracking report format to all Region 5 States. This report format consolidates all of the Title V permit issuance information that we are currently tracking into a single quarterly report. Based on feedback we received for the July-September reporting cycle, we would like to clarify some of the permit data elements to ensure that all permitting authorities are submitting the same information. In addition, we have made a few minor adjustments to the tracking report format. The updated permit data tracking format and the data element clarifications are enclosed.

We appreciate the efforts of you and your staff in helping us identify and address these Title V permit tracking elements. Please use the enclosed updated format for the next reporting cycle. Because of the changes to the format, we are extending the next report date to January 24, 2005, for the October-December quarter.
