Dear Mr. Huber:

Our counsel at the U. S. Department of Justice has conveyed what we understand to be Summit's request for an additional time to submit certified, supplemental information regarding its operations as addressed in U. S. Environmental Protection Agency's letter to Summit dated February 23, 2010. By this e-mail, and in response to Summit's request, we extend until April 23, 2010, the deadline for Summit to make its certified submission to EPA. While we have extended Summit's deadline, we urge Summit to make its submission earlier if possible, as EPA wants to move expeditiously on this matter and complete it within the timeframe indicated in EPA's February 23, 2010, letter.

We also understand from the U. S. Department of Justice counsel that Summit has requested a call with EPA to discuss the details of its submission of information and related certification.
