The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed the draft Title V renewal permit, permit number P0118978, for the Ford Motor Company, located in Sharonville, Ohio. To ensure that the source meets Federal Clean Air Act requirements, that the permit will provide necessary information so that the basis of the permit decision is transparent and readily accessible to the public, and that the permit record provides adequate support for the decision, EPA has the following comments:

1. Pages 28 and 38 both list 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart JJJJJ as an applicable requirement for Boilers 1A and 1B (EUB023, EUB024) and Boilers 2 and 3 (EU B002, EUB003). Please list the specific applicable requirements of Subpart JJJJJ that the emission units are subject to, and include the necessary monitoring, testing, record keeping and reporting requirements. The draft permit lists Subpart JJJJJ as an applicable requirement for Title V, therefore, the specific requirements that apply to the source need to be in the permit.
2. Pages 33-37 lists emission testing as an applicable method to determine compliance with emission limits for particulate matter, sulfur dioxide, nitrogen oxides, and carbon monoxide. However, these permit conditions do not specify the testing frequency. Please revise the permit conditions to include testing frequency.
