
AN ACT to amend Act No. 348 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled as amended "An act to control air pollution in this state; to create an air pollution control commission within the state health department; to prescribe its powers and duties; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain county agencies; to provide for the establishment of fees; and to provide penalties." as amended, being sections 336.11 to 336.36 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 7a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 348 of the Public Acts of 1965, as amended, being sections 336.11 to 336.36 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 7a to read as follows:

Sec. 7a. Notwithstanding any other provision of this act or the rules promulgated under this act, car ferries having the capacity to carry more than 110 motor vehicles and coal-fueled trains used in connection with tourism or an historical museum, or carrying works of art or items of historical interest are not subject to regulation under this act.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
