SECTION 1. 326 IAC 8-12-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

### 326 IAC 8-12-2 Exemptions

Authority: IC 13-14-8; IC 13-17-3-4

Affected: IC 13-12

Sec. 2. The following marine coatings are exempt from the volatile organic compound emissions limiting requirements contained in section 4 of this rule:

(1) Any marine coating used in volumes of less than ~~twenty (20)~~ **twenty-five (25)** gallons in ~~any one (1)~~ **any one (1)** calendar year, provided; however, The total of all exempt coatings shall not exceed ~~four hundred (400)~~ **two hundred sixty-four (264)** gallons in any one (1) calendar year.

(2) Any marine coating applied using a hand-held aerosol can.

(3) Any marine coating used in a touch-up operation.
