

(27) (a) "Significant" means, in reference to a net emissions increase or the potential of a source to emit any of the air contaminants in Table A, a rate of emissions that would equal or exceed any of the rates in Table A.

Table A
Pollutant and Emissions Rate

1. Carbon monoxide: 100 tons per year (tpy)
2. Nitrogen oxides: 40 tpy
3. Sulfur dioxide: 40 tpy
4. Particulate matter: 25 tpy
5. PM10: 15tpy
6. Ozone: 40 tpy of volatile organic compounds
7. Lead: 0.6 tpy
8. Asbestos: 0.007 tpy
9. Beryllium: 0.0004 tpy
10. Mercury: 0.1 tpy
11. Vinyl chloride: 1 tpy
