**R 336.1661 Definitions for consumer products.**

Rule 661. As used in R 336.1660:

(a) The “OTC state” means state of Michigan.

(b) “Volatile organic compound” or “VOC” means a compound as defined in 40 C.F.R. §51.100 (2006). For the purpose of clarifying the definition, the provisions of 40 C.F.R. §51.100 (2006) are adopted by reference in these rules.
