

Response To Comments

Prestige Custom Cabinetry & Millwork Inc.

EPA prepared for public notice a draft Part 49 synthetic minor construction permit for Prestige Custom Cabinetry & Millwork (SYN-ON-55009R0004-2014-01) for the after the fact construction of a wood cabinet manufacturing facility. The comment period for the draft permit ended on December 1, 2014. EPA received comments from the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin and from Jim Rabideau, consultant for Prestige Custom Cabinetry & Millwork. The following are the comments and EPA's response to those comments.

1) The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin provided the following corrections:

Prestige Custom Cabinetry & Millwork, Inc. is located on trust lands within the exterior boundary of the Oneida Nation of Wisconsin's reservation.

- Prestige Cabinetry is not on trust land. It is on non-Tribally owned fee land.
- It is the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin reservation (as stated in the cover letter), not the Oneida Nation of Wisconsin's reservation.

EPA will revise the permit per the comments.

2) Prestige provided the following comments:

- Page 4, 1.0 Facility Description
 - Please modify the SIC code to 2434.
- Page 5, 2.0 Unit and Facility Specific Requirements, (A). Emission Limitations and Standards, 1. Facility Synthetic minor limitations, i. VOCs, B.
 - Please change the following to "The permittee shall not emit more than 3.71 tons/month based on a 12 month rolling average."
- Page 5, 2.0 Unit and Facility Specific Requirements, (A). Emission Limitations and Standards, 1. Facility Synthetic minor limitations, ii. HAPs, A.
 - Please change the following to "The permittee shall not emit more than 9.9 tpy of any single HAP, 1,666 lbs/month based on a 12 month rolling average."
- Page 5, 2.0 Unit and Facility Specific Requirements, (A). Emission Limitations and Standards, 1. Facility Synthetic minor limitations, ii. HAPs, B.
 - Please change the following to "The permittee shall not emit more than 24.9 tpy of combined HAPs, 4,166 lbs/month based on a 12 month rolling average."
- Page 6, 2.0 Unit and Facility Specific Requirements, (B). Monitoring and Testing, 1. Monitoring.
