
Dear Mr. Alexander:

On January 20, 2012, Al-Kel Alliance, Inc. (Al-Kel) was issued a Unilateral Administrative Order (UAO) by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) concerning the Al-Kel facility located at 2012 Goode Rd. in Wilmer, Texas (Facility). The UAO, issued under Section 3013 of RCRA, required Al-Kel to perform site assessment and evaluation, including delineation of soil, sediment, and groundwater contamination associated with the Facility.

Based on the Administrative Record for the Facility, EPA has determined that Al-Kel has fully satisfied the provisions and has satisfactorily completed the terms of the UAO. Pursuant to Section XX (Termination and Satisfaction) of the UAO, the UAO is hereby terminated.
