

**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue an Authority to Construct to Occidental of Elk Hills for Heavy Oil Production Source located within the NW/4 of Section 2, Township 31S, Range 23E, California. Occidental of Elk Hills is proposing to install a new 324 bhp Tier 3 diesel-fired emergency internal combustion (IC) engine powering an electric generator at within their emergency response facility.
