NOTICE OF PROPOSED TITLE V RENEWAL PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) is proposing to renew the existing Title V permit that was previously issued to the following facility:

This is an existing facility applying for a Title V permit renewal that is engaged in the manufacturing of various paper products such as facial tissue and paper towels. The facility operates creped wadding machines, mixers, printers, a bath tissue line, multifolders, boilers, emergency internal combustion engines, a gas turbine, and other supporting equipment. Particulate matter emissions from the paper manufacturing operations are controlled by several scrubbers, drum filters and a baghouse. Carbon monoxide, volatile organic compounds, and nitrogen oxide emissions from the gas turbine are controlled by an oxidation catalyst and a selective catalytic reduction system.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and SCAQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facility has submitted a Title V renewal application and requested the SCAQMD to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permit incorporates updates to the facility information provided in the facility's Title V renewal application and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

The proposed permit is available for public review at the SCAQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765, the Fullerton Public Library, 353 W. Commonwealth Ave, Fullerton, CA 92832, and on our website at www3.aqmd.gov/webappl/publicnotices2/, by entering the company's name or facility ID number. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the SCAQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the SCAQMD based on credible information, is also available from the SCAQMD for public review. Comments must be received by December 19, 2014. The SCAQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with SCAQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request the SCAQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Hamed Mandilawi at the above SCAQMD address. The SCAQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permit is not correct or is not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permit.
