**Background/Process Description**

Chino Basin Desalter Authority (CDA) A/N 561007 was submitted for Title V permit de minimis significant revision (03) on November 2, 2010. Application 516006 was submitted for the alteration of the ammonia storage tank with sparger to increase the maximum throughput of ammonia. Public notice is not required. For additional information and permit evaluation please refer to the attached evaluation prepared for EPA review.

Note: Title V Revision 01 (A/N 436881) was issued July 22, 2005. Title V Revision 02, Renewal (A/N 487701) was issued on September 15, 2011.

**Rules Evaluation**

Reg. XXX:

The alteration of the ammonia storage tank with sparger is considered a Title V De Minimis Significant permit revision under Rule 3000(b)(6), since the cumulative emission increases of non-RECLAIM pollutants or HAPs do not exceed the emissions in Table 5-4 of the Draft Title V TDG March 2005 and does not result in new or additional NSPS or NESHAP requirements and will be subject to an EPA review (Rule 3003(j)). A public notice is not required. Compliance is expected.

**Conclusions and Recommendations**

A Permit to Operate is recommended for application 516006. A revised Title V permit is recommended for after the completion of EPA review.
