NOTICE OF PROPOSED TITLE V RENEWAL PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) is proposing to renew the existing Title V permit that was previously issued to the following facility:

This is an existing facility that is engaged in the fabrication of steel products. The facility operates spray booths, plasma arc cutting system, cement mixing system, abrasive blasting systems, and other supporting equipment. Particulate matter (PM) emissions from the abrasive blasting systems are vented to air pollution control equipment baghouses.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and SCAQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facility has submitted a Title V renewal application and requested the SCAQMD to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permit incorporates updates to the facility information provided in the facility's Title V renewal application and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

The proposed permit is available for public review at the SCAQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765, the Lewis Library and Technology Center, 8437 Sierra Avenue, Fontana, CA 92335, and on our website at www3.aqmd.gov/webappl/publicnotices2/, by entering the company's name or facility ID number. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the SCAQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the SCAQMD based on credible information, is also available from the SCAQMD for public review. Comments must be received by August 18, 2016. The SCAQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with SCAQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request the SCAQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Hamed Mandilawi at the above SCAQMD address. The SCAQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permit is not correct or is not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permit. Public hearing request forms and the schedule of public hearings may be obtained from the SCAQMD website at <http://www.aqmd.gov/home/permits/title-v/public-notices-and-hearings>. Requests for a public hearing are due by August 2, 2016. A copy of the hearing request must also be sent by first class mail to the facility contact person listed above.

Right to Petition U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for Reconsideration: Title V Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If a public comment is sent to the SCAQMD for the above permits, and the SCAQMD has not addressed the comment in a satisfactory manner, and the EPA has not objected to the proposed permits, then the public may submit a petition requesting that the EPA reconsider the decision not to object. Petitions shall be submitted to US EPA, Region 9, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of the 45-day EPA review period.
