## NOTICE OF PROPOSED TITLE V RENEWAL PERMITS

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is proposing to renew the existing Title V permits that were previously issued to the following facilities:

This is an existing facility applying for a Title V permit renewal that is engaged in the manufacturing of adhesive-backed film for the electronic industry. The facility operates coaters, ovens, a spray booth, a solvent still, a diesel fired emergency internal combustion engine, a classifying screen and associated air pollution control equipment HEPA filter, mixers and associated air pollution control equipment baghouses, and other supporting equipment. The coaters, spray booth, five ovens and one baghouse are operated in a permanent total enclosure (PTE) and the volatile organic compound emissions from the PTE is controlled by an air pollution control equipment afterburner.

This is an existing facility, applying for a Title V permit renewal that is in the business of aircraft manufacturing. The facility operates surface preparation lines, abrasive blasting cabinets and associated air pollution control equipment dust collectors, avgas fuel storage and dispensing system, spray booths, a powder spray booth and

associated air pollution control equipment dust collector, ovens, a drying room, and other supporting equipment. Two of the spray booths and two drying ovens are operated in a permanent total enclosure and the volatile organic compound emissions from this equipment are vented to an air pollution control equipment regenerative thermal oxidizer.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, each of the above facilities has submitted a Title V renewal application and requested the AQMD to renew their Title V permit. Each of the proposed permits incorporates updates to the facility information provided in the facility's Title V renewal application and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

The proposed permits are available for public review at the AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and at the Los Angeles Public Library, Science, Technology, and Patents Department, 630 West 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Los Angeles, CA 90071. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. Comments must be received by March 13, 2012. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request the AQMD to conduct a public hearing on any of the proposed permits by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G)

to Hamed Mandilawi at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permits are not correct or are not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permits.
