The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received and reviewed a Title V application for a Minor Permit Revision to the BP Company's (BP) Facility Permit.

BP has submitted a revised compliance plan to comply with the Rule 1173 pressure relief device (PRD) monitoring requirements. The revised plan will replace BP's current Rule 1173 Compliance Plan, submitted and approved under Application No. 495358. The AQMD plans to approve the revised plan with conditions as shown on the attached draft approval letter. There will be no impact on emissions as the plan is for installing monitoring devices to track releases from PRDs.

As required under Rule 3003(j), AQMD is providing a copy of the proposed permit to the EPA for a 45-day review. A copy of the proposed revision to the existing Title V Permit, Section I, our draft plan approval letter and plan evaluation are attached for your review.
