Mercury Plastics, Inc. (I.D. 058563) has proposed to revise their Title V permit by adding a new flexographic printing press and regenerative thermal oxidizer, and by modifying an existing regenerative thermal oxidizer by replacing the burners. This is a plastic bag manufacturing facility (SIC 4286) located at 14849 Salt Lake Avenue, City of Industry, CA 91746. This proposed permit revision as requested under Application No. 563673 is considered as a “de minimis significant permit revision” to their Title V permit. Attached for your review are the permit evaluations and draft permit for the proposed permit revision. With your receipt of the proposed Title V permit revision today, we will note that the EPA 45-day review period will begin on June 24th.
