NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF TITLE V PERMITS

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is the air pollution control agency for all of Orange County and portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. This is to inform the public of the intention of the AQMD to renew the existing Title V permit previously issued to the facility listed below.

LACSD operates the above inactive landfill facility. Permits for the above landfill generally consists of a gas collection system, a condensate/leachate collection system, flare stations and other ancillary equipment necessary for daily operation of a landfill. The proposed renewal permit is also updated to reflect changes at this facility, including removal of Permits to Operate two boilers from Section D and removal of Permits to Construct a fuel cell and microturbines from Section H.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance, unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facility has submitted Title V renewal application and requested that AQMD renew their Title V permit. The proposed permits incorporates updates to the facility information, as provided in the facility's Title V renewal application, as well as updates to all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility. As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, the Title V permit include all of the emission limits, applicable requirements and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facility is required to certify compliance with the Title V permit in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation from the permit conditions.

The proposed permit is available for public review at AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765, and at the Peninsula Center Library, 701 Silver Spur Road, Rolling Hills Estates, CA 90274. The proposed permit can also be viewed at www.aqmd.gov/webappl/publicnotices/search.aspx by entering the facility ID number. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. **Anyone wishing to comment on the issuance of the proposed permit should submit their comments in writing by February 7, 2012.
