Re: Notice of Proposed Decision - Significant Title V Permit Modification F-00012-9.

Dear Mr. Rios:

Enclosed for your review and comment are the District's proposed revised Title V operating permit F-00012-9, Authorities to Construct (ATCs) and Emission Evaluations C-11-76, C-11-77, & C-11-78, and Public Notice, for the Buckeye Terminal, LLC facility operating at 1601 South River Road in West Sacramento, California.

This notification is given in accordance with District Rule 3.8, Section 409.1 (a 30-day public notice comment period) and Sections 409.1.e and 411 (a concurrent 45-day regulatory review period) for a significant Title V permit modification. The proposed revisions are necessary due to the pending issuance of the following ATC applications which propose an increase in the maximum Reid Vapor Pressure allow to be stored in affected bulk aboveground gasoline storage tanks during the first and fourth calendar quarters:

- C-11-76 [Tank #15] modifying Permit to Operate (PTO) P-54-93(t1);
- C-11-77 [Tank #16] modifying PTO P-66-93(t1); and
- C-11-78 [Tank #18] modifying PTO P-45-94(t1).

The three ATC applications listed above have been processed in accordance with the Enhanced New Source Review requirements of District Rule 3.4, Section 404. Section 404.1 of District Rule 3.8, requires that upon the implementation of the ATCs into PTOs, Buckeye Terminals request, in writing, that the District amend the Title V operating permit to incorporate the proposed modifications.

The notice of preliminary decision for this project will be published in the West Sacramento Press newspaper approximately three (3) days from the date of this letter. Please submit your written comments concerning this project within the 45-day regulatory comment period which will begin on the date that the documents are received by your agency. As such, the District respectfully requests notification of the date that the enclosed documents are received.
