

## NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District invites interested persons to submit written public comments on the proposed Significant Revision to a Major Facility Review Permit and the proposed Acid Rain Permit for the following Facility:

The purpose of the significant revision is to install three 45 MW turbines for the purpose of generating electricity, to change the existing permit conditions to allow installation of the project, and to issue an Phase II Acid Rain permit to the facility.

The proposed increase in emissions is:

Nitrogen Oxides	39.5 tons per year
Precursor Organic Compounds	6.9 tons per year
Carbon Monoxide	36.0 tons per year
Sulfur Dioxide	1.9 tons per year
PM10	14.7 tons per year

Major facilities and Phase II Acid Rain facilities are required to obtain operating permits under Title V of the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments, the Federal Operating Permit Program and the District's Regulation 2, Rule 6 - Major Facility Review. The permits summarize all air-related requirements that apply to each source of emissions at each facility.

The Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer invites written comment on the above proposed permit. Comments must be received within 30 days of the date of publication. The public may also request a public hearing for this permit.

Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed permit and District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review, to reconsider the issuance of the permit.

The proposed Major Facility Review permit, application, and the Final Determination of Compliance are available for public inspection at the District Headquarters, 939 Ellis Street, San Francisco, CA 94109, in the Permit Services Division, 3rd Floor. There is no compliance report because the sources have not yet been installed.
