Comments must be received by December 26, 2012. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request the AQMD to conduct a public hearing on any of the proposed permits by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Hamed Mandilawi at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permits are not correct or are not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permits. Public hearing request forms and the schedule of public hearings may be obtained from the AQMD website at <http://www.aqmd.gov/titlev>. Requests for public hearings are due by December 11, 2012. A copy of the hearing request must also be sent by first class mail to the appropriate facility contact person listed above.
