NOTICE OF PROPOSED RENEWAL OF TITLE V PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is the air pollution control agency for the four county-region including all of Orange County and non-desert portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. Rule 3006 requires that the AQMD publish this notice prior to the renewal of a Title V permit previously issued to the facility listed below:

This is an existing facility applying for a Title V permit renewal. In addition, this facility is changing ownership and incorporating minor permit revisions. The facility was formerly Tesoro Refinery & Marketing Company (ID 151984). The minor revisions include a modified Rule 462 plan and a new Rule 463 plan. This is a bulk terminal which stores and distributes petroleum products. The facility operates storage tanks, tank truck loading racks, a waste water treatment system, and a vapor control system.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such a permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facility submitted a Title V permit renewal application and requested the AQMD to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permit incorporates updates to the facility information, as provided in the facility's Title V renewal application, as well as updates to all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, the Title V permit includes all the emission limits, applicable requirements and operating conditions on the equipment, including the requirements of 40CFR Part 64, Compliance Assurance Monitoring (CAM). Title V facilities are required to certify compliance with the Title V permits in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation of the permit conditions.

The proposed permit is available for public review at AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and

at the Lomita Public Library, 24200 Narbonne Ave., Lomita, CA 90717. The proposed permit can also be viewed at www.aqmd.gov/webappl/PublicNotices/Search.aspx by entering the facility's ID number. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. **Anyone wishing to comment on the issuance of the proposed renewal permit should submit their comments in writing by November 16th, 2012. The public hearing request must contain all the information requested on the form in order for the AQMD to determine whether or not the request is valid and if a public hearing will be held. At the same time, a copy of the hearing request must also be sent by first class mail to the facility contact person listed above at the same time.**
