Arlon, Materials for Electronics Division (I.D. 046646) has proposed to revise their Title V permit by modifying an existing oven in a currently permitted coating line. The applicant is proposing to modify the oven by replacing the burners with low NOx burners. This will reduce NOx emissions and is expected to comply with the Rule 1147 requirements of 30 ppmv NOx. The oven is used to cure fiberglass resin coating.

This is an electronic materials lamination facility (SIC 3083) located at 9433 Hyssop Drive, Rancho Cucamonga, CA 91730. This proposed permit revision as requested under Application Number 530201 is considered as a “de minimus significant permit revision” to their Title V permit. Attached for your review are the permit evaluation and draft permit for the proposed permit revision. With your receipt of the proposed Title V permit revision today, we will note that the EPA 45-day review period will begin on January 18<sup>th</sup>.
