Bristol Fiberlite Industries, Inc. (ID 111110) has proposed to revise their Title V permit by replacing an air pollution control system consisting of a carbon adsorber and a thermal oxidizer with a regenerative thermal oxidizer (RTO) with a low NOx burner and to vent an oven to this new RTO. This is a translucent skylight manufacturing facility (SIC 3446) located at 401 E. Goetz Avenue, Santa Ana, CA 92707. This proposed permit revision as requested under Application Number 554203 is considered as a “de minimus significant permit revision” to their Title V permit. Attached for your review are the permit evaluation and draft permit for the proposed permit revision. With your receipt of the proposed Title V permit revision today, we will note that the EPA 45-day review period will begin on December 6th.
