NOTICE OF PROPOSED TITLE V RENEWAL PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is proposing to renew the existing Title V permit that was previously issued to the following facility:

This is an existing facility, applying for a Title V permit renewal, that is engaged in the manufacturing and packaging of plastic adhesives and solvent cements. The facility operates storage tanks, holding tanks, mixers, container filling stations, and other supporting equipment. Particulate matter emissions from the mixers are vented to air pollution control equipment baghouses. Volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions from the holding tanks and mixers are vented to air pollution control equipment carbon adsorbers. VOC emissions from the container filling stations are vented to air pollution control equipment regenerative thermal oxidizers.

Pursuant to Title V of the Federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such permit has been renewed.

Accordingly, the above facility has submitted a Title V renewal application and requested the AQMD to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permit incorporates updates to the facility information provided in the facility's Title V renewal application and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

The proposed permit is available for public review at the AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and at the Los Angeles County Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Library, 17906 South Avalon Blvd., Carson, CA 90746. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. Comments must be received by October 28, 2008. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request AQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Rodney Millican at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permit is not correct or is not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permit. The request for a public hearing is due by October 14, 2008. A copy of the hearing request must also be sent by first class mail to the appropriate facility contact person listed above.
