
Enclosed for your 45-day review are the proposed revision to the Title V facility permit for Chevron Products Company (Chevron) located at 324 West El Segundo Blvd, El Segundo, California. The proposed revision is a de minimis significant revision and a public notice is not required.

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) has received applications for Permits to Operate from Chevron for the equipment described in table below. The SCAQMD has evaluated the applications and made a preliminary determination that the equipment will operate in compliance with all of the applicable requirements of our rules and regulations.
