## NOTICE OF PROPOSED RENEWAL OF TITLE V PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is the air pollution control agency for the four-county region including all of Orange County and non-desert portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. Rule 3006 requires that the AQMD publish this notice prior to the renewal of a Title V permit:

This is an existing facility applying to renew their Title V permit. This facility is a municipal solid waste landfill facility. Permits for the above landfill consists of a gas collection system, landfill condensate/leachate collection systems, a landfill gas flaring system, an internal combustion engine emergency generator, and a fuel storage & dispensing facility.

Pursuant to Title V and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance, unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facility submitted a Title V permit renewal application in order to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permit incorporates updates to the facility information and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility, including the requirements of 40 CFR Part 64, Compliance Assurance Monitoring (CAM).

As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, Title V permits include all the emission limits and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facilities are required to certify compliance with the Title V permits in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation from the permit conditions.

The proposed permit is available for public review at AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and at the Lake View Terrace Branch Library, 12002 Osborne Street, Lake View Terrace, CA 91342. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. **Anyone wishing to comment on the issuance of the proposed permit should submit their comments in writing by July 11, 2012.** Written comments should be submitted to:
