Dear Mr. Rios:

New Basis, LLC (ID 40806) has proposed to revise their Title V permit by installing two mixers, two silos, two storage tanks, and one weigh hopper, by modifying an existing air pollution control system and six silos, and by updating permit conditions for an existing mixer. This is a fiberglass parts manufacturing facility (SIC 3089) located at 2626 Kansas Avenue, Riverside, CA 92507. This proposed revision as requested under Application Number 554851 is considered as a “significant permit revision” to their Title V permit. Attached for your review are the permit evaluation, public notice, and draft permit (Section D) for the proposed permit revision. With your receipt of this proposed permit revision today, we will note that the EPA 45-day review period will begin on May 30, 2014.

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) has received fifteen applications for Permits to Construct and Operate from New Basis, LLC for the equipment described in the enclosed notice. Pursuant to SCAQMD Rule 212 - Standards for Approving Permits and Issuing Public Notice, new or modified sources exceeding any of the specified daily maximums are subject to the public notification and comment provisions of 40 CFR Part 51, Section 51.161(b), and 40 CFR Part 124, Section 124.10. The public notice requirements for Rule 212 and Title V have been combined into one notice to be conducted simultaneously.

The SCAQMD has evaluated these applications and made a preliminary determination that the equipment will operate in compliance with all of the applicable requirements of our Rules and Regulations. Therefore, the SCAQMD is proposing to issue permits to New Basis, LLC for the equipment described in the enclosed notice.

Please find enclosed a public notice for New Basis, LLC issued in accordance with Rules 212(g) and 3006. The public notice provides for a 30-day comment period (which ends June 30, 2014) prior to making a final decision on the issuance of the permits and is being published in a newspaper of general circulation in the vicinity of this facility. This notice is being sent to the U.S. EPA, California Air Resources Board, Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG), County of Riverside, City of Riverside, State and Federal Land Managers, Antelope Valley AQMD, Imperial County APCD, Mojave Desert AQMD, San Diego APCD, Ventura County APCD, and all other affected states and Indian Governing Bodies.
