Proposed Significant Revision to Title V Permit for Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts (LACSD),
Joint Water Pollution Control Plant (ID#800236)

Enclosed for your 45-day review is the proposed revision to the Title V Permit for LACSD, municipal waste water treatment plant located at 24501 South Figueroa Street, Carson, CA in Los Angeles County. This revision is considered to be a significant permit revision because the proposed equipment installation is subject to NSPS and NESHAPS and a public notice is required. The initial Title V permit for this facility was issued on January 12, 2009 and permit revision (01) was issued on May 14, 2009. The proposed Title V permit includes the addition of four plasma arc cutters issued under A/Ns 479877, 479878, 479879 and 479880 and three emergency internal combustion diesel engines to drive emergency electrical generators issued under A/Ns 497322, 497323 and 497787. The facility has requested the changes listed above, and filed application No. 501741 for a significant revision to the Title V facility permit.
