Regal Cultured Marble (ID No. 149241) has proposed to revise their Title V permit by installing a new regenerative thermal oxidizer (RTO) venting two existing spray booths, modifying two ovens to vent to the RTO, and changing permit conditions on three spray booths, three ovens and an open spray system. This is a manufacturer of custom bathroom fixtures (SIC 3281) located at 1239 & 1275 E. Franklin Avenue, Pomona, CA 91766. This proposed permit revision as requested under Application Number 503253 is considered a "de minimis significant permit revision" to their Title V permit. Attached for your review are the permit evaluation and draft permit for the proposed permit revision. With your receipt of the proposed Title V permit revision today, we will note that the EPA 45-day review period will begin on August 11<sup>th</sup>.

Pursuant to AQMD Rule 212 - Standards for Approving Permits and Issuing Public Notice, new or modified sources exceeding any of the specified daily maximums are subject to the public notification and comment provisions of 40 CFR Part 51, Section 51.161(b), and 40 CFR Part 124, Section 124.10.

Please find enclosed a public notice for Regal Cultured Marble issued in accordance with Rule 212(g). The public notice provides for a 30-day comment period prior to making a final decision on the issuance of the permit, and is also being published in a newspaper of general circulation in the vicinity of this facility. This notice is being distributed to each address within a ¼-mile radius of the property line of the facility. This notice is also being sent to the California Air Resources Board, the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG), the County of Los Angeles, the City of Pomona, and the State and Federal Land Managers.
