**NOTICE OF PROPOSED REVISION TO TITLE V PERMIT
PURSUANT TO AQMD RULE 3006**

This notice is to inform you that the South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received application for modification of existing equipment at Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company's Wilmington refinery. The AQMD is the air pollution control agency for the four county-region including Orange County and parts of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino counties. Anyone wishing to install or modify equipment that could control or be a source of air pollution within this region must first obtain a permit from the AQMD. Rule 3006 requires the AQMD to prepare and distribute a public notice for certain projects prior to the issuance of a revision of the facility's Title V permit. This notice is being issued because a significant revision of Tesoro's Title V permit is being proposed.

The AQMD has evaluated the permit applications for the following equipment and determined that the equipment will meet all applicable air quality requirements of our Rules and Regulations.

509883	Storage tank 80071	Modify storage tank from a fixed roof tank vented to vapor recovery system to an internal floating roof tank with approved seals.

The AQMD will revise the existing Title V permit for this facility to reflect the Permit to Construct/Operate for above listed equipment. As required by Title V of the Federal Clean Air Act, the revised Title V permit includes all of the emission limits and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facility is required to certify compliance with the Title V permit in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any violations of the permit conditions. The Title V permit is enforceable by the AQMD, by the federal government, and by the citizens.

The proposed permit and air quality analysis are available for public review during normal business hours at the AQMD's headquarters, 21865 Copley Drive, in Diamond Bar, CA. A copy of the draft permit can also be viewed at www.aqmd.gov/webappl/PublicNotices/Search.aspx by entering the facility ID number. Information regarding the facility's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD, based on credible information, is also available for public review at AQMD headquarters.

The public may request the AQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed Title V permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Ms. Sawsan Andrawis at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed Title V permit is incorrect or is inadequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and that a public hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permit. Public hearing request forms and the schedule of public hearings may be obtained from the AQMD by calling the Title V hotline at (909) 396-3013, or downloading from the internet at <http://www.aqmd.gov/titlev>.
