NOTICE OF PROPOSED RENEWAL OF TITLE V PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is the air pollution control agency for the four-county region including all of Orange County and non-desert portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. Rule 3006 requires that the AQMD publish this notice prior to the renewal of a Title V permit:

These facilities operate landfill gas fired internal combustion engines driving electric generators.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance, unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facilities submitted a Title V permit renewal application in order to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permit incorporates updates to the facility information and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, Title V permits include all the emission limits and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facilities are required to certify compliance with the Title V permits in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation from the permit conditions.

The proposed permits are available for public review at AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and at the Colton Library, 656 N. 9th Street, Colton, CA, Ontario Public Library, 215 East C Street, Ontario CA, and the Rialto Public Library, 251 West 1st Street, Rialto, CA. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. **Anyone wishing to comment on the issuance of the proposed permits should submit their comments in writing by October 15, 2013.** Written comments should be submitted to:

The public may request AQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed Title V permits by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Abdi Majidifar at the above AQMD address. The public hearing request must contain all the information requested on the form in order for the AQMD to determine whether the request is valid and if a public hearing will be held.
