Re: Response to Public Comments on Initial Title V Permit for Sunshine Gas Producers Renewable Energy Project and Sunshine Canyon Landfill Title V Renewal and Revision

Dear Community Members:

South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) staff appreciates your participation in the Title V permitting for the projects referenced above for the Sunshine Gas Producers, LLC (SGP) and Sunshine Canyon Landfill (SCLF). Public comments received during and subsequent to the public comment periods and in conjunction with the public consultation meeting held by the AQMD on April 18, 2012, have been carefully reviewed and evaluated by AQMD staff. Based on this review, AQMD staff has prepared a written response to the comments that are related to the proposed permits (please see the attachment entitled *Responses to Permit-Related Public Comments*). Comments that are related to the Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (DSEIR) for the SGP Renewable Energy Project have been addressed in the Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (FSEIR) and in the second attachment to this letter entitled *Further Responses to Public Comments Related to the Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report*.

After having considered all comments received, AQMD staff has determined that the equipment associated with the proposed SGP project, with the use of appropriate air pollution control devices, meets all the applicable standards, rules and regulations. The FSEIR for the proposed SGP project was certified (approved) by the AQMD Executive Officer on April 27, 2012. Therefore, the above reference permits for the SGP project have accordingly been issued on April 27, 2012.

Similarly, AQMD staff has considered all comments received on the SCLF Title V permit renewal and revision and concluded that it meets all the applicable standards, rules and regulations and is on schedule complying with its obligation in accordance with the April 22, 2010 Order for Abatement and its subsequent amendments. Therefore, the above referenced permits for SCLF have also been issued on April 27, 2012.


