Proposed Significant Revision to Title V Permit for Sunshine Canyon Landfill (SCL) Facility ID# 49111

Enclosed for your review is the proposed revision to the Title V Permit for Sunshine Canyon Landfill, located at 14747 San Fernando Road, Sylmar, CA, in Los Angeles County. This facility is an active municipal solid waste landfill, applying for a permit to construct/operate a new flare.

This revision is considered to be a significant permit revision and a public notice is required. We are enclosing the proposed permit revision and the engineering evaluation for the applications described below.



In addition, pursuant to SCAQMD Rule 212 – Standards for Approving Permits, subdivision (c)(2), new or modified sources exceeding any of the specified daily maximums are subject to public notification and comment provisions of 40 CFR Part 51, Section 51.161(b), and 40 CFR Part 124, Section 124.10. The SCAQMD has evaluated these applications and made a preliminary determination that the proposed revisions will comply with all of the applicable requirements of our Rules and Regulations. The public notice requirements for Rule 212 and Rule 3006 have been combined into one notice to be conducted simultaneously.

Enclosed for your 45 day review is the proposed Title V permit, and the engineering evaluation for the application described above and the public notice. SCAQMD intends to publish a 30-day public notice shortly and make the proposed revised permit available for public review in accordance with Rule 3006 and Rule 212.
