The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received and reviewed a de minimis significant Title V revision application from RRI Energy, Etiwanda Generating Station, located at 8996 Etiwanda Ave, Rancho Cucamonga, CA 91738. The permit revision is for a new emergency fire pump engine.

The AQMD has evaluated this application and made a preliminary determination that the equipment will be operated in compliance with all of the applicable requirements of our rules and regulations.

The AQMD is required under Rule 3005(e) to provide a copy of the proposed permit to the EPA Administrator for a 45-day review. As such, a copy of the proposed revision to the existing Title V permit is attached along with our engineering analysis for your review.
