RE: DRAFT TITLE V PERMIT

Dear Mr. Lewis:

Enclosed is a draft of the initial Title V permit for your review. Concurrently, the South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is releasing the proposed Title V permit for review by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the public. To this end, the AQMD has incorporated the following changes to your draft Title V permit since the issuance of the most current revision of your RECLAIM Facility Permit:

- Condition C8.2: Added Rule 1303(a)(1) - BACT and Rule 401 as underlying rules for this periodic monitoring.
- Condition D28.1: Added Rule 407 as underlying rule for this periodic monitoring condition.
- Conditions D28.1, D28.3, D28.4, D28.5, D28.6, D28.7, and D28.8: Tagged these conditions with Rule 3004(a)(4) - Periodic Monitoring.
- Condition D28.2: Tagged this condition with Rule 1303(a)(1) - BACT and Rule 1303(b)(2) - Offset, and Rule 3004(a)(4) - Periodic Monitoring..
- Conditions D322.1, D322.2, D323.1, and D381.1: Added Rule 401 as underlying rule for these periodic monitoring conditions.
- Condition K67.1: Added Rule 401 as underlying rule for this periodic monitoring condition.

To begin the public review period of the draft Title V permit, the AQMD will publish a notice in the legal section of a newspaper in the vicinity of the INEOS Polypropylene Plant that will appear on or about June 17, 2008. This notice allows the public the opportunity to comment on your facility's proposed initial Title V permit, pursuant to AQMD Rule 3006. The public comment period is at least 30 days from the date of publication and EPA has 45 days to review and comment. Enclosed are copies of the public notices in English and Spanish, Permit Summary, and proposed initial Title V permit for your facility.
