Title V Permit Revision (A/N/s 514166, 514986, 527497)


Consolidated Foundries - Pomona (ID 126536) has proposed to revise their Title V permit by changing conditions for their sand mixing systems to increase throughput (A/N 514159), clarify toxic compounds used in the systems (A/N's 514159, 514161, 514164, and 527494), and addition of two electric aluminum melting furnaces (A/N's 514984,5). The changes are summarized below:

Consolidated Foundries – Pomona manufactures aluminum and magnesium castings for a variety of aerospace and defense applications located at 4200 W. Valley Boulevard, Pomona, CA. The proposed permit revision is considered as a “de minimis significant permit revision” to their Title V Permit. Attached for your review are the evaluations and proposed permit for this revision.
