## NOTICE OF PROPOSED RENEWAL OF TITLE V PERMIT

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is the air pollution control agency for the four county-region including all of Orange County and non-desert portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. Rule 3006 requires that the AQMD publish this notice prior to the renewal of a Title V permit previously issued to the facilities listed below:

These facilities are gasoline/diesel bulk loading terminals and operate storage tanks, tank truck loading and unloading racks, liquid separation and recovery systems, and vapor recovery systems.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless such a permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facilities submitted a Title V permit renewal application and requested the AQMD to renew their Title V permit. The proposed permits incorporate updates to the facility information, as provided in the facility's Title V renewal application, as well as updates to all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, the Title V permit includes all the emission limits, applicable requirements and operating conditions on the equipment. Title V facilities are required to certify compliance with the Title V permits in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation of the permit conditions.

Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. **Anyone wishing to comment on the issuance of the proposed renewal permit should submit their comments in writing by August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014.
