Enclosed for your 45-day review is the proposed revision to the Title V facility permit for Chevron Products Company (Chevron) located at 324 W. El Segundo Blvd, El Segundo, California. Chevron's initial Title V permit was issued on October 12, 2009. The revision proposed under application A/N504230 is a Minor Revision and a public notice is not required.

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received applications for Permits to Operate from Chevron for the equipment described in table below.
