**CHANGES TO DRAFT ATC:**

The source suggested revisions to the draft permit that are presented below:

1. Condition IV-C-8: The Permittee shall demonstrate compliance with the opacity limitation on a monthly basis in accordance with 40 CFR 60 Appendix A: Method 22 (Visual determination of fugitive emissions). The observations should be made for a period of 6 minutes in order to confirm that no visible emissions are present. If visible emissions are present, compliance with the opacity limitation shall be further demonstrated in accordance with 40 CFR 60 Appendix A, Method 9 (Standards for Opacity). [AQR 12.5.2.6(d)]

**Proposed change:** The natural gas air heater (EU: B12) vents internally into the building and opacity measurements are not possible. This unit is fueled by natural gas only. The source requested that EU: B12 be exempted from this condition.

**DAQEM Response:** The compliance demonstration with the opacity limitations is based on visual determination of fugitive emissions (EPA Method 22), if no visible emissions are observed the opacity determination (EPA Method 9) is not required. Since the EU: B12 vents into the building, the opacity cannot be determined inside the building and the unit is exempted from the Method 9 requirements based on the method applicability and there is no need to change the condition IV-C-8.

1. Condition IV- F-5: The following requirements apply to quarterly reports:  
[AQR 12.5.2.6(d)]

- a. The report shall include a quarterly summary of each item listed in Section IV-E-4.
- b. The report shall include quarterly summaries of any permit deviations, their probable cause, and corrective or preventative actions taken.
- c. The report shall be submitted to DAQEM within 30 calendar days after the due date.

**Proposed change:** The word semi-annual should be replaced with quarterly to make the sentence consistent with condition F-4 as well as Table IV-F-1.

**DAQEM Response:** The condition has been changed as requested.
