In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), Section 11-60.1, and pursuant to your significant modification application, the Department of Health hereby amends the subject covered source permit. This amendment adds a 250 HP boiler in the subject permit. The issuance of this amendment is based on the information that you submitted as part of your application dated June 12, 2007. A receipt for the application filing fee of \$500.00 is enclosed.

The following Special Condition No. A.1 in Attachment II, issued with CSP No. 0442-02-C dated February 15, 2005, is superseded as follows:

1. This permit encompasses the following equipment and associated appurtenances:
 - a. Two (2) 500 HP synthetic natural gas (SNG) / fuel oil no. 2 fired Cleaver-Brooks steam-generating boilers (model no. CB-LE-200-500-250, serial nos. OLO98601 and OLO98602); and
 - b. 250 HP SNG / fuel oil no. 2 fired Miura steam-generating boiler (model no. EX-250-SGO, serial no. tbd).

The following Special Condition No. B.1 in Attachment II, issued with CSP No. 0442-02-C dated February 15, 2005, is superseded as follows:

1. The 500 HP boilers are subject to the provisions of the following federal regulations:

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- a. 40 CFR Part 60, Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources, Subpart A, General Provisions; and
- b. 40 CFR Part 60, Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources, Subpart Dc, Standards of Performance for Small Industrial-Commercial-Institutional Steam Generating Units.

The following Special Condition No. C.1.c in Attachment II, issued with CSP No. 0442-02-C dated February 15, 2005, is superseded as follows:

- c. The total combined fuel oil no. 2 consumption for all three (3) boilers shall not exceed 1,000,000 gallons in any rolling twelve (12) month period.

The following Special Condition No. C.3 is added to CSP No. 0442-02-C dated February 15, 2005, as follows:

3. No more than two (2) boilers may operate simultaneously.

The following Special Condition Nos. No. D.1.b and c in Attachment II, issued with CSP No. 0442-02-C dated February 15, 2005, are superseded as follows:

- b. The permittee shall maintain and operate a non-resetting volumetric fuel meter (in gallons) to record the total amount of fuel oil no. 2 burned for all three (3) boilers. The meter shall permanently record the total gallons of fuel oil no. 2 consumed by the boilers for the purpose of the fuel limitation specified in Special Condition No. C.1.c.
- c. The following information shall be recorded for the total consumption of fuel oil no. 2 by all three (3) boilers:
 - 1) Date of meter readings;
 - 2) Beginning meter readings for each month;
 - 3) Total fuel oil no. 2 consumption for each month; and
 - 4) Total fuel oil no. 2 consumption on a rolling twelve (12) month basis.

All other permit conditions issued with CSP No. 0442-02-C dated February 15, 2005 shall not be affected and shall remain valid.
