Enclosed for your 45-day review is the proposed revision to the Title V facility permit for BP West Coast Products LLC (BP) located at 2350 E. 223<sup>rd</sup> Street, Carson, California. BP's initial Title V permit was issued on September 1, 2009. The revision proposed under application A/N 516427 is a Minor Revision.

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received an application (Application Number 527965) from BP for amendment of its Rule 1173 Compliance Plan. Rule 1173 requires installation of electronic devices for monitoring of releases from atmospheric Pressure Relief Devices (PRD)s. The updates of the Rule 1173 Compliance Plan include: listing of atmospheric PRDs which are no longer subject to monitoring requirements, amendment of the electronic process parameter to be monitored, and elimination of conditions which are outdated or otherwise no longer applicable. This Rule 1173 Compliance Plan supersedes the one approved under A/N 510012. There will be no impact on emissions as a result of this plan amendment. The AQMD plans to approve the revised plan with the conditions shown in the attached draft approval letter. The revised portion of the permit (Section I of the Title V permit), the draft plan approval letter, and our evaluation report are attached for your review.
