NOTICE OF PROPOSED REVISION TO TITLE V PERMIT

This notice is to inform you that the South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has received applications for modifications to existing equipment at BP West Coast Products LLC, Carson Refinery. The AQMD is the air pollution control agency for Orange County and portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. Anyone wishing to operate, install or modify equipment that could be a source of air pollution within this region must first obtain a permit from the AQMD. Since this facility has a Title V permit, Rule 3006 requires publication of a public notice prior to the issuance of certain revisions to Title V permit.

The AQMD has evaluated the permit applications for the following equipment and determined that the equipment will meet all applicable air quality requirements of our Rules and Regulations.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Revise permit conditions for existing Claus Units as described below

397368	Claus Unit "A"	Change of permit status from "Permit to Construct" to "Permit to Operate", remove obsolete Conditions E182.5 and E193.6, and allowing venting directly to tail gas incinerator during startups, shutdowns and malfunctions. Impacts on emissions are not expected from these changes
397363	Claus Unit "B"	Same as above
461441	Claus Unit "C"	Same as above
461442	Claus Unit "D"	Same as above except the current permit does not have conditions E193.6 and D182.5.

The AQMD will revise the existing Title V permit of this facility in accordance with all applicable rules and regulations. As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, the Title V permit includes all of the emission limits and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facility is required to certify compliance with the Title V permit in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any violations of the permit conditions. The Title V permit is enforceable by the AQMD, by the federal government, and by the citizens.

The proposed permits and air quality analysis are available for public review during normal business hours at the AQMD's headquarters, 21865 Copley Drive, Diamond Bar, CA. A copy of the draft permit can also be viewed at www.aqmd.gov/webappl/PublicNotices/Search.aspx by

entering the facility's ID number. Information regarding the facility's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD, based on credible information, is also available for public review at AQMD headquarters.

The public may request the AQMD to conduct a public hearing on the proposed revision to the Title V permit by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Mr. Rafik Beshai at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed Title V permit is incorrect or is inadequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and that a public hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permit.
