Dear Mr. Venturini:

This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District has made administrative permit amendments to the Major Facility Review Permit for Orcon Corporation (Facility Number A1675).

Since Orcon Corporation operates under the Small User Exemption of Regulation 8-20-110, Orcon Corporation has requested that we group all printing equipment sources together as one source so that they can keep better track of combined ink usage and emissions from the printing operations. The District's November 7, 1996 Grouping Policy allows the grouping of coating and/or printing operations, if combined emissions are less than 3,000 pounds per year. Orcon Corporation has agreed to permit conditions that limit emissions to 175 pounds per month or 2,100 pounds per year. Therefore, we have grouped sources S13-S17 into one source, S13, Combined Printing Operation.
